

SAND SPRINGS RECHARGE AREA: A land area covering approximately 18,000 acres north of the Smoky Hill River between the cities of Abilene and Solomon.

The area, which is characterized by highly permeable soil and dune sand deposits, provides essential recharge to unconsolidated and bedrock aquifers beneath the surface. Both aquifers have unusually high transmissivities and ground water velocities.
